

Dear customers,

VTB Bank (Kazakhstan) hereby in accordance with clause 1.7. of the Adhesion Contract on opening a current account (for legal entities and their separate subdivisions (branches, representative offices)), approved by the Management Board of the Bank (Minutes No.16 dated March 10, 2021), subject to amendments and supplements (hereinafter referred to as the Contract), notifies the bank's customers who have joined this Contract and opened current accounts on its terms and conditions, of changes in the bank's tariffs for payment services rendered under the Contract from April 01, 2024, namely:

1) commission fee for the Customer's request, provision of an electronic reference related to the Customer's service with the Bank (including the turnover reference for periods not exceeding 1 year), delivered electronically via "Internet Banking" Remote Banking Service (including VAT). – 0 KZT;

2) commission fee for Exchange operation of non-cash currency funds when crediting money to the Customer's Bank Account (at the Bank's exchange rate at the time of the operation, provided that the Customer's account has the required amount): – 0 KZT;

In accordance with the terms of the Contract, on the third business day after the notice is posted, you have the right to send a written refusal signed by your authorized representative to the bank.

Please note that according to clause 1.7. of the Contract, the bank's failure to receive a written refusal signed by your authorized representative on the third day after the notice has been posted indicates your agreement with the bank's tariffs for payment services rendered under the Contract and is a sufficient confirmation of your will to use the current account on the changed terms and conditions. Such consent is recognized as full and unconditional.
