

**SafeNet eToken 5100\5105 electronic key media operation memo.**



- 1) Protect e-Token from mechanical impacts (falling, shock, vibrations, etc.), high and low temperatures, aggressive media, high voltage; these can lead to its damage.
  - 2) Do not apply excessive force when connecting the device to a computer port.
  - 3) Do not disassemble the e-Token! In addition to losing the product's warranty, such actions may result in damage to the body, as well as deterioration or breakage of printed-circuit wiring and, as a result, unreliable operation or failure of the identifier.
  - 4) You may only connect the e-Token to properly functioning equipment.
  - 5) Do not use long adapters or USB hubs without additional power, as this may result in inadequate voltage being applied to the input intended for the identifier.
  - 6) Do not leave the e-Token connected to your computer during rebooting, sleep mode, because during this time, voltage drops on the USB port may occur and, as a result, the device may be damaged.
  - 7) It is not recommended to leave the e-Token connected to the computer when it is not in use.
  - 8) It is recommended to disconnect other USB devices while working with the e-Token.
- A large number of USB devices may lead to significant changes in the power supply modes of USB ports of the computer and, as a result, failure of the e-Token.

Please take into account this information and consider it in your work.
